SEPTIC SYSTEM RETROFIT REBATE PROGRAM

We are offering a \$200.00 rebate to Oakland Bay Clean Water District homeowners to retrofit their existing septic system with septic tank risers or effluent filters or both.

The following conditions must be met for work performed by a Mason County Certified Pumper, Installer or an Operation and Maintenance Provider:

1. Existing system must be in the Oakland Bay Clean Water District.
2. Submit a paid invoice from the provider, your name, address, telephone number and parcel number to Mason County Public Health for the \$200.00 rebate.
3. Septic tank risers shall be at finished grade.
4. Access for effluent filters shall be at finish grade
5. Gasket type seal required between riser and lid.
6. Jet set riser to tank or some other acceptable method to assure water tightness.

The following conditions must be met for a homeowner installation:

1. Existing system must be in the Oakland Bay Clean Water District
2. Call 360-427-9670 extension 353 for an inspection after installation has been completed.
3. Submit a paid invoice for the materials, your name, address, telephone number and parcel number to Mason County Public Health for the \$200.00 Rebate check.
4. Septic tank risers shall be at finished grade.
5. Access for effluent filters shall be at finish grade



Q and A

• What is a septic tank riser and why would I want one?

A septic tank riser is an extension of your tank up to the ground level which provides access to your tank (for both pumping and inspections) without having to dig up your yard which can be labor intensive and expensive.

• What is an effluent filter and why would I want one?

An effluent filter helps to extend the lifespan of your onsite septic system by preventing (filtering) solids from leaving your septic tank and entering your drainfield.

• What are the boundaries of the Oakland Bay Clean Water District?
